



- 2001P** KRISTINA (1626–(1632)–1644–1654), Queen of Sweden. Beautiful rare own signed resolution/decision with her lovely royal paper seal still attached, dated in Stockholm August 12, 1647. Content about that the old soldier Peder Carsson should have two free barrel of grain each year from the Crown and that he is according to an earlier resolution/decision 1638 free from service as soldier. On back it is written up for each year he had got the two barrels and from who. Finnish places as 1649 Storsavolax, 1653–1653 Telenäs. Good quality but fragile, some paper separation and a little paper loss. Transcription enclosed. 3.000:-
- 2002P** KRISTINA (1626–(1632)–1644–1654), Queen of Sweden. Part of manuscript signed Christina and then more writing on same item dated in Stettin September 25, 1647 and Stettin October 13, 1647, about payment. Also including are several printed pages of Kristina's Baptism at Gripsholm November 30, 1623 (rare item), then cut outs from other documents (her signature and paper seal) and a postcard. Good quality but some paper losses and an item a little burned at right. Transcript enclosed of the 1647 item. (6) 1.000:-







- 2003P HEDVIG ELEONORA (1636–1660–1715). Queen of Sweden 1656– and regent during the minority of Karl XI 1660–1672 and during the minority of Karl XII 1697. Interesting letter content of that Freidrich Leijer is ordered to do and deliver several tables and stools for Karlberg (then just outside Stockholm) and royal castle from 1688. Dated in Carlberg July 10, 1703. Transcript enclosed. Very scarce item! 1.000:-
- 2004P KARL XI (1655–1672–1697). Very interesting letter content, dated in Stockholm May 9, 1696 and signed Carolus. The letter content is an application from Anders Mårtensson Hällendorf "an old and poor man" to get the final payment for many years of different service for the Swedish Navy. Mention e.g he had served on Havsfrun which was captured by the Danish 1677 and later served in Göteborg under Amiral Erik Siöblad. Transcript enclosed. Good quality but with some paper loss. Also enclosed two coins from 1666 & 1686 with less value. Scarce item! 1.000:-
- 2005P KARL XII (1682–1697–1718), King of Sweden. Signed document with Carolus in Bender (near Black Sea) May 3, 1712. The document is part of an incoming message about help (and payment for service and goods to the Swedish Crown) to the estate of Antoni von Boij, founder of several minings, hammers etc during 50 years. Now deceased and the estate is in badly need of money to pay their own debts. The document has been strenghten, reinforced and has some paper separation. Transcript of the King's message is enclosed. Very rare item. 2.500:-







- 2006P** ULRIKA ELEONORA (1688–1718–1741). Queen of Sweden 1718–. Interesting Royal proclamation signed by Ulrika Eleonora in Stockholm September 27, 1731, while active regent during her husband's travel to Hessen (Germany). Also more writing in Finland and e.g dated in Helsinki October 23, 1731 by P. S. Stierncrantz. Then sent by Crown Mail with lovely crown coil with notation "to be published in Sarijärfwi and Witasarij" and "conveyed by district postal farmers through night and day". Multiple signs of natural aging. Scarce to find Ulrika's signature on document when acting as ruler in the King's absence. Ok quality regarding to the rarity. Transcription enclosed. 1.000:-
- 2007P** FREDRIK I (1676–1720–1751). King of Sweden. A resolution (decision) dated in Stockholm in the council chamber December 19, 1729, signed Friedrich and attached his royal paper seal. Content is about the farmer's Anders Erichsson at Berga (maybe that near Fellingsbro, Örebro county) contract from May 2, 1720. Rare item in good quality! 1.000:-
- 2008P** ADOLF FREDRIK (1710–1751–1771), King of Sweden. Letter content about a pension fund and dated Stockholm in the council chamber November 20, 1761, stamped "Adolph Friedrich". The use of a royal name stamp was earlier done under the previous Swedish king as he went old and was not in good health. The Parliament gave from May 26, 1756 the council right to use the name stamp to also sign government decisions which Adolf Fredrik refused to sign. For signature reference is also enclosed a letter in German signed by Adolf Fredrik 1741 (before his election as Swedish Crown Prince). Scarce item in good quality! 1.000:-






- 2009Da** GUSTAF III (1746–1771–1792). King of Sweden. Very interesting document with nice Royal paper seal and signed Gustaf. Dated at Stockholms Castle April 3, 1778 (322×204 mm). This is a permission, for the request sent to the King by pastor Johan Wikelius in Järsnäs parish, Jönköping County, given to the farmer Israel Israelsson at Hult, Lommaryd, Jönköpings County to remarry after infidelity in his previous marriage with Chatarina Jönsdotter. Where she is already remarried. Rare to document this kind of story. The item is nicely framed, for wall display, size 42×32 cm. Transcription enclosed. Very good quality! 2.000:-
- 2010P** GUSTAF III (1746–1771–1792). King of Sweden. Interesting document (3½ page) mentioning the establishment of The Duke Carl's "Drabantkår" with the Colonel Robert von Rosen as highest officer. Dated at Drottningholm Casle October 7, 1790 and signed Gustaf. Good quality but have been folded. 1.200:-
- 2011P** GUSTAF IV ADOLF (1778–1796–1837). King of Sweden–1809. Appointment signed "Gustaf Adolph", dated at Carlsruhe Castle (Baden) July 11, 1804 during his and the families stay at his parents in law. And with his royal paper seal still attached. Regarding 2nd Lieutenant (Fänrik) Michael Silvius von Hohenhausen (1790–1849) at the Finnish Life Guards. Rare item in good quality! 1.000:-
- 2012P** KARL XIII (1748–1809–1818). Regent of Sweden during the minority of Gustaf IV Adolf 1792–1796. He was the younger brother of Gustaf III. Beautiful mourning letter (due to King Gustaf III's death) with black edges and black seal. Signed Carl and dated Drottningholm Castle September 26, 1792 to Count Rosen by courier. Scarce item in good quality! 1.000:-







- 2013P KARL XIII (1748–1809–1818). Regent of Sweden during the minority of Gustaf IV Adolf 1792–1796. He was the younger brother of Gustaf III. Letter to Colonel N F Jernfeltz in Norrköping. Easy to read. Dated at Stockholm Castle April 18, 1793, signed Carl and his royal seal in black on back (due to King Gustaf III's death = mourning letter). Scarce item in good quality but some paper separation. 1.000:-
- 2014P KARL XIII (1748–1809–1818). Regent of Sweden during the minority of Gustaf IV Adolf 1792–1796. He was the younger brother of Gustaf III. Three letter content signed by Carl. The first (1page) dated at Stockholm Castle April 26, 1793 is a permission for major for 6 months leave, the second (2½ pages) dated in Drottningholm September 1793 to Colonel N F Jernfeltz, the Life Grenadier Regiment and in the content is mentioned "for valour in the field" (för tapperhet i fält). The third is item (1½ page) is dated in Stockholm Castle March 14, 1796 and to the Ministry of War about the dismissed Lieutenant Gabriel Silljander, Regiemnt of Skaraborg to live at Hoffmanstorp (in the area of the same regiment). Transcription is enclosed for two of them, the other is an easy read. Scarce itrems in good quality! 1.200:-
- 2015K KARL XIII (1748–1809–1818). Regent of Sweden. Nice letter signed Carl and dated on October 24, 1809 at Stockholm Castle. By Swedish Mail with listing number "15" to the commander of Närkes and Värmlands Regiment in Örebro. Full content and about to prepare for a general mustering of the regiment. Rare to document this. Fine quality! 1.500:-
- 2016P KARL XIII (1748–1809–1818). Regent of Sweden, also during the minority of Gustaf IV Adolf 1792–1796. Interesting letter content 1½ written pages, that is about the progress of road construction between Dalarna and Värmland, that had already cost more than planned and that a report at the end of the year is requested. Dated at Stockholm Castle April 7, 1813, signed Carl and A Mörner (Count Adolph Göran Mörner af Morlanda). Transcript enclosed. Rare document in good quality! 1.500:-

- 2017K Carl Bonde (1581–1652). Governor of Dalarna with the copper and iron mines (1607–) and Governor of Västerås and Västmanland including Sala silver mine 1613–. The document is signed on July 20, 1616 and is mentioning amount of bar iron (stångjärn). There is a memorial dated on June 19, 1616 in which he is mentioned for his actions against the ongoing for years extensice copper stealth trade. Which was more or less then solved. Good quality for this scarce item. 1.000:-



2018

**2018K** Beautiful and very rare letter by Royal courier, signed "Carolus" (Swedish King Karl IX), dated in Kalmar October 20, 1603. Nice ornament and with his royal paper seal attached on outside. Sent to the governor Torsten Lindormsson Forstena (1561–1631) at Elfsborg Castle (outskirts of Gothenburg). Torsten was then father to Field Marshal Lennart Torstensson. The King was in Kalmar to organize a new campaign in Polish Livonia (ongoing war with Poland), where he actually minted new coins. The Elfsborg (Älvsborg) fortress was conquered by the Danes May 22, 1612 (Kalmar War 1611–1613) and it was determined in the Peace that Sweden had to pay 1 million Riksdaler silver coins, to be paid in four instalments: 1616, 1617, 1618 and 1619 before Älvsborg was handed back. Very good quality although folded a long time ago.

**2019K** Very early and rare courier letter with very nice handwriting, dated at Stockholm Castle August 4, 1605. Punched with device and probably smoked to desinfect the letter. During whole year 1605 the plague haunted Stockholm. Full beautifully written content. Also in August Karl IX sailed from Stockholm across the Baltic Sea with a fleet of about 40 warships and transport ships with troops for a campaign in Polish Livonia and besieged Riga. Excellent quality!

**2020K** Beautiful written courier letter to Chancellor of the Swedish Crown (=Axel Oxenstierna) with a nice little red seal on back. Notation on back "Presented May 25/ Feb 4 1634". Oxenstierna was leader of the Government during the minority of Queen Kristina 1632–1644 which 1636 set up the Swedish Mail. Very good quality!



**2021K** Nice small with beautiful written address in 7 rows and with ornament to Court Martial (Krigsrätten) in Stockholm. Notation on front "Presented in Krigsrätten October 7, 1635" and with a little red seal on back. Scarce item. Good quality.

**2022P** KARL XI (1655–1672–1697). Very interesting signed letter addressed to the Judge over Västernorrland, Bergslagen and Dalarna Håhan Fägerstierna in Falun. Dated in Stockholm February 5, 1685 and signed Carolus. Also still attached the Royal paper seal, but divided when the letter was opened. Transcript enclosed and some facts about the King. Rare item in good quality!

**2023P** JEAN BAPTISTE BERNADOTTE (1763–1818–1844), French Brigadier General 1794– . From 1818 King of Sweden and Norway. Rare letter and very decorative content from the French Ministry of War to Liège (under French occupation) about e.g accomodation of French prisoners of war. Signed JB. Bernadotte and dated in Paris (France) 14 Fructidor (year) 7 (= 4 September 1799) according to the French republican calendar which was only used for about twelve years. Good quality!


**2024K** Fantastic cover ("ordres") with a beautiful crown coil and a large fluffy feather, with arrival notes from "Stratontä den 15 Januarii 1813", "Bränestad" and "Thorlanda den 16 Januarii 1813", and with a final note "afsänd till Dofwestad Betygar under min Brors frånvaro". The back with small paper residues after mounting. A most interesting item.

**2025K** Lovely cover (slightly reused) with notation "Ordres!", and with a beautiful crown coil and a large feather. Arrival notes from four locations, Stratontä, Kumla, Thorslunda and Tornby, on the same date 12.12.1808.



**2026K** Nice feather (blue) letter conveyed by soldiers from Färgelanda (Västergötland) to Forstena (Västra Tunhem between Vänersborg and Trollhättan). Notation at bottom from 2nd Lieutenant Lars Enbohm (also his seal on back), "dispatched from Ferglanda March 20 (1828), 6 PM and to delivered by Extra Solider Mail". To Väst-Götha Dals Regiment (Infantry regiment 16) with a small crown coil and written content. Good quality but have been folded horizontally. Scarce item.







**2029K** Sweden. Nice rare letter by Swedish Royal Mail to Stralsund, Swedish Pomerania from Kalmar (Småland), dated on May 9, 1768. Notation "2" = second weight class and with listing number "1". Full written content. Scarce to find such early letter from Kalmar and Småland to Swedish possessions and abroad. Fine quality!

**2030K** Sweden. Very early letter by the Swedish Royal Mail to Stralsund, Swedish Pomerania from Stockholm, dated on November 29, 1781. Notation "Recomens" at top right suggest that it should be sent as registered. Also notation "franco" and listing number "2" which later had been changed. Letter in the first weight class. Full written content sent to the chamberlain Johann David von Reichenbach (1732–1807). He became member of the chamber council for the Swedish Pomerania 1772. This letter is the earliest recorded registered letter (not in archive's) to Swedish Pomerania from Sweden, according to our knowledge. Fine quality!

**2031K** Sweden. Nice rare letter to Wismar from Stockholm, dated on October 29, 1793. The addressee was the Swedish Jakob von Mühlenfels working at the Royal High Tribunal in Wismar. Full written content of several pages and sent with courier. Scarce item to the Swedish possession Wismar! Fine quality!

- 2032K** Norway. Official letter sent from PITEÅ 10.4.1843 via the rarely used mountain mail route via Haparanda, Karesuando and Mauno, to Tromsø 8.5.1843. ## Auction conditions

The auction is voluntary and is conducted on behalf of the vendors. The lot shall be sold to the person making the highest bid at a sum equal to the next highest bid plus a fixed increase. If there is only one bid the lot will be sold for the starting price. In the event of two identical bids the first bid received has priority.

All bids must be made in Swedish crowns (SEK). All invoices pertaining to auction purchases are made out by AB Philea, the financial and legal counterpart to all buyers and vendors at the auction.

Commission of 25 % is added to the hammerprice for both domestic and foreign customers. AB Philea uses the "Margin scheme" (also known as the "Global System") meaning that no VAT will be specified on invoices. When incurred, expenses for insurance and postage are also added.






